



ESCOPPURTUNITY IN SLOVENIA

Social Integration of migrant children and young adults





Slovenia has long been the destination of many Balkan immigrants and our town Krško is no different. As youth workers we see many youngsters struggle with the language, culture, and everyday interactions with their peers and the local community. The project offers these youngsters an opportunity to fully grasp and better understand the new environment.

Activities

The young participants will primarily work in our center as part of the activities visited by vulnerable target groups.

In the afternoon you will help in our daily centre Freedom.

The Daily centre Freedom is open 4 times a week, for 3 hours a day. During the school holidays, the volunteer will focus on his own project and ideas that they want to develop

One part of the volunteers activities will also take part in local schools.

In the warmer months we also do street work, where we go on the streets of Krško and hang out with the kids there.









Accomodation

You will be staying in the new youth hostel located inside the youth center (separate ESC apartment, furnished 4 single rooms, 2 bathrooms, 2 kitchens, 1 living room, all air conditioned), each will have their own room and will share the apartment with another volunteer. There is also a laundry room, drying room, some bicycles, and wi-fi available.



Finance

You will receive a monthly deposit for food, which will be determined in the activity agreement, along with pocket money, which comes to about 350 euros per month.



Other useful informaton

Social security will be provided in the activity agreement between partners and volunteers, where we will define accommodation, insurance, the amount of the costs for food, pocket money, working hours, weekly schedules, and holidays (2 days/month) ...

You will be provided with all the necessary support before leaving for ESC adventure (departure training, general things about ESc, Youthpass, Europass, logistical issues, information about Krško, our center...

Upon arrival, you will attend an on-arrival training that will be organized by NA, where all the ESC volunteers in Slovenia come together and get to know each other and the ESC program in general.

Upon arrival, you will also receive a mentor. They will introduce you to life in a new environment, and help you build a social network. You will also receive a working mentor, that will help you with all scheduled activities.

You will get a Slovenian online language course. As the Youth center Krško is located in the very center of Krško, the local activities can be reached by foot or bicycle. For the remoted activities public transport will be used (paid by the hosting org.). Infrastructure and equipment for the implementation of activities will be provided by the host organization, as are visual aids.
